

LINC Teacher Training FAQ



1. Is there a cost for LINC Providers?

No, the training is free for LINC instructors. We are grateful to *Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada* for their continued financial support in the LINC teacher training in the BC/Yukon region. Each participant will receive 30 hours of LINC focused training over 6 weeks (5 hours/week).

2. Is the program taught remotely?

Yes, it is fully remote. The training includes two components:

- Asynchronous online activities (3 hours/week) on Moodle
- Synchronous weekly review sessions (once a week, 2 hours/session) live on Zoom, every Saturday 9 - 11AM (Pacific Time).

3. Who is the trainer?

The course is led by an experienced LINC teacher trainer from MOSAIC. Each week she facilitates the 3 hours of online activities, provides online feedback, and leads the group discussion and review session on Saturday.

4. How is the course different from CLB Bootcamp or PBLA training?

The course is designed to complement—not repeat—CLB or PBLA training. It offers both new and experienced instructors practical strategies for lesson planning, classroom delivery, and teaching across modalities. It also provides important opportunities to connect, share, and learn from fellow instructors.

5. Is there a certificate at the end?

A certificate of completion will be provided to participants who complete the course at the end of the cohort.
